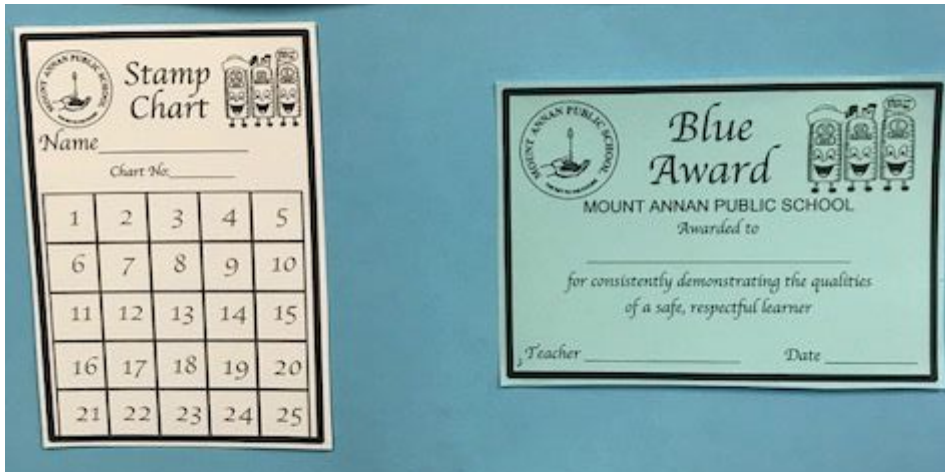


Mount Annan Public School Award System

(To begin 2018)



In class, students will be able to earn stamps for being a safe, respectful learner. Once students have 25 stamps they achieve a

Blue Award.

(To be presented in class)

The stamp system will begin Week 3, Term 1 and run in classrooms until the end of Week 5, Term 4.



When students have earned 5 Blue Awards, they will achieve a

Gold Award.

(To be presented in front of the stage at a date in Term 4 to be advised by each stage. Parents are welcome to attend)



Every fortnight, teachers will select 2 students from their class (K-2) and 3 students (3-6) based on merit to be presented with a **Merit Award.**

(To be presented at students only stage assemblies. Merit Awards will not be handed out after Week 6, Term 4)



To earn a **Platinum Award**, students must have earned a Gold Award and 2 Merit Awards throughout the year. Teachers will keep a record of Merit and Gold Awards.

(To be presented by Mrs O'Neill at a K-2 and 3-6 award assembly in Week 8 of Term 4. Parents are welcome to attend)

The award system begins again each year. Awards CANNOT be carried over from one year to the next.

Celebration of Learning Awards, Education Week Awards and Presentation Day Awards sit outside of this system.
