

Mount Annan Public School Award System

(To begin Week 4, Term 1 2022)



In class and from other staff, students will be able to earn on the spot Blue Awards for being safe, respectful learners.

Students will need to keep these awards in a safe place. Once they have 5, they must be brought back into school to be sighted for a Gold Award.



When students have earned 5 Blue Awards, they will achieve a **Gold Award**. It is possible for students to earn more than one Gold Award per year.

Students will need to bring their 5 awards into school. Teachers will sign the back of the award to show they have been sighted and a Gold Award achieved. There is NO limit.

(To be presented at a stage only assembly as they are earned and recognised in the school newsletter)



Every term, teachers will receive Merit Awards which will be handed out at fortnightly stage assemblies. K-2 will give out 3 a fortnight and 3-6 will give out 4. AU classes 1 per fortnight and IO 2 per fortnight.

(To be presented at students only stage assemblies)



To earn a **Platinum Award**, students must earn a Gold Award and 2 Merit Awards. To be awarded with a Platinum Award, students must bring in their 2 Merits and 1 Gold to show their classroom teacher. Teachers will sight the awards and keep a record.

These will be handed out at stage assemblies AS THEY ARE EARNED and shared in the newsletter.
