Accidents/Illness/Medication

In the event of a minor incident, first aid will be administered by staff and recorded on the MAPS sick bay register. If a more serious incident occurs, parents will be contacted immediately. Please ensure the office has current telephone numbers including numbers for <u>each child's emergency contact person</u>. In emergency situations, an ambulance may be called.

If a child has to take medication during school hours, written authorisation from the parent/guardian must be obtained. Medication forms are available at the school office. The container must bear the original label with the child's name, dosage instructions and the time/s it needs to be administered. Staff can only administer medication prescribed by a doctor. The office requires the names of the people who may be contacted in the event of a child becoming ill during the day. Any medicine administered to your child is recorded on the sick bay register. Medication must be handed directly to the office by the parent/ guardian.

Please keep children at home when they are sick. A child who isn't healthy cannot concentrate on schoolwork and may also spread germs to other children and teachers.
